

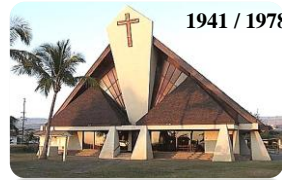

LENLEN REGULATIONS

- Catholics aged 18 through 59 are bound to fast on both Ash Wednesday (Feb. 26, 2020) and Good Friday (April 10, 2020).
- Catholics aged 14 and up are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday
- All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year.
