We are excited to share the upcoming Hawaii 2021 March for Life!

On behalf of Hawaii Life Alliance, the Catholic Dioceses of Honolulu and the Knights of Columbus, I would like to invite you to participate in the very important Hawaii March for Life event which will take place on Friday, January 22 from 4pm - 6pm. Due to the continued uncertainty regarding the coronavirus pandemic, the event will be virtual.

For this reason we are partnering with our churches and parishes by highlighting the lives lost to abortion in Hawaii via prayer service, a march by the Knights of Columbus and the displaying of pinwheels on church grounds. This year's emphasis also includes these Life Issues:

Hawaii Life Alliance is a Hawaii-based 501(c) 3 organization dedicated to LIFE ISSUES, rooted in a Biblical worldview.

This year's theme, **"For We are God's Masterpiece"**, comes from Ephesians 2:10. The apostle Paul is emphasizing that God Himself took great delight in making you. So much so throughout scripture God talks about the intimate details of our lives even in

the womb. Because of this incredible truth, together we will commentate the more than 400,000 babies lost to abortion in Hawaii since its legalization in 1970. The unborn children that were also God's masterpiece.

The event time is 4pm - 6pm. "Virtual doors open at 3:45pm with praise and worship by the Tamala ohana. The schedule includes keynote presentation, the displaying of pinwheels and banners with our theme, along with special messages from Bishop Larry Silva, Arimathea Bennett from Students for Life, Pastor Waxer Tipton from One Love Ministries and more.

Bishop Larry Silva of the Catholic Diocese of Honolulu will hold a special prayer vigil to kick start the event with Mass and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on Thursday, January 21, at 6:00 p.m. at Co-Cathedral of St. Theresa, Honolulu. All Catholic Churches are encouraged to join Bishop Silva by having their own Mass and Adoration at the same time.
