



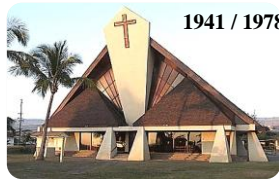

2021 Lenten Regulations

- **FASTING:** Catholics aged 18 through 59 are to fast on both Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. To fast means to consume one (1) full meal a day at most. Food and drink between meals with the exception of water and medicine, is not permitted on fast days.
- **ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT:** Catholics aged 14 and up are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday.
