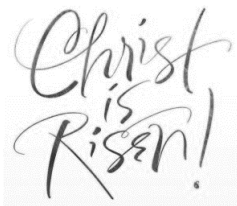

## Fire Safety

One of our Parishioners is a Kauai Red Cross volunteer, and she would like us to remain aware of the dangers of Fire in our home.

Home fires claim approximately seven lives every day, but you can help change that by pledging to keep your family safe. Take two simple steps to protect you family: Practice your 2-minute family fire drill and test your smoke alarms monthly.

To keep our families safe, Kauai Red Cross volunteers are involved in a program called *Sound the Alarm*. These volunteers are able to set up virtual visits or phone calls with any families who want to receive home fire safety education, create/practice the 2-minute fire drill, and work with the local fire department to install smoke alarms (if needed).
