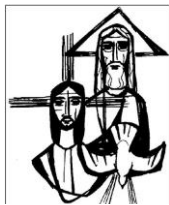


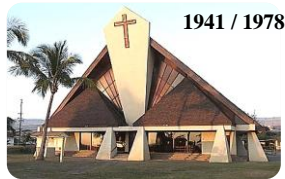

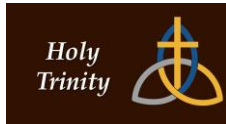
FEAST OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY May 30, 2021
