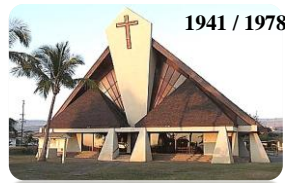

### Cannot marry in the Catholic Church due to a prior marriage???

Pope Francis has streamlined the process to petition for a declaration of nullity to make the process shorter. He also eliminated the mandatory fee. If a person is able to prove in this process that their prior marital bond was invalid for some reason, then he or she can marry in the Catholic Church or validate a current civil marriage. Bishop Larry will preside over the convalidation Mass next year on June 3, 2023 at Immaculate Conception Church in Lihue. This will allow time for those interested to prepare for the sacrament.
